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MANAGEMENT OF DUSHTAPRATISHYAYA W.S.R. TO CHRONIC RHINOSINUSITIS WITH CHATURJAT CHURNA PRADHAMAN NASYA AND VYOSHADI VATI - A SINGLE CASE STUDY

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ABSTRACT

Dushtapratishyaya or Chronic Rhinosinusitis is very common complaints in clinical practice seen in urban places. This drags patient to doctor because of severe headache, purulent nasal discharge, nasal obstruction, foul smell through nose, heaviness and altered olfaction. Nasal congestion, prurulent discharch, altered secretion and blockage are chief events in Dushtapratishyaya. Elimination of mucous, reliving of obstruction, cleansing the channel is the line of treatment. The present case study is about female patient having Dushtapratishyaya. Acharya Yogratnakar has advised a Chaturjat Pradhaman Nasya in treatment of Pratishyaya. [1] In other words Shodhan with tikshna, ushna, kaphahara dravyas having ugra gandha are to be selected. So Chaturjat Pradhaman Nasya and Vyoshadi vati orally as a shaman chikitsa were given to the patient which results in improvement.

INTRODUCTION

Dushta Pratishyaya is a chronic stage of pratishyaya and kapha dosha is predominant in this condition. Dushtapratishyaya has not mentioned as a separate disease but, rather it considered to be the complication of different type of pratishyaya. [2] According to sign and symptoms the disease Dushtapratishyaya can be correlated with chronic rhinosinusitis. The disease characterized by facial pain, purulent nasal discharge, nasal obstruction, headache, anosmia heaviness in head etc. [3] Elimination of mucous, reliving of obstruction, cleansing the channel is the line of treatment.

So the *chaturjat pradhaman Nasya* having antitoxic, antimicrobial, antiviral, anti allergic properties and *vyoshadi vati*^[4] having *deepen*, *pachana*, *strotoshodhan*, *vatanuloman*

, shothahara and rasayan properties are to selected.

AIM AND OBJECTIVES

- ✓ To assess the effect of chaturjat pradhaman nasya and vyoshadi vati in Dushtapratishyaya.
- ✓ To establish the Ayurvedic line of treatment in chronic rhinosinusitis.

CASE STUDY

A female patient of age 27 years old which is housewife

by occupation comes to OPD of *shalakyatantra* with C/O -

- 1. Anosmia (3yrs)
- 2. Foul smell through nose (2yrs)
- 3. Headache (1.5yr)
- 4. Nasal obstruction / difficulty in breathing (1.5yrs)
- Yellowish thick discharge through nose (1.5yr) H/O
 allergy to dust

No H/O DM/HTN or other major illness Family history – NAD $\,$

O/E – Nasal cavity (anterior rhinoscopy)

- Congested/ inflamed nasal mucosa
- Minimal DNS towards left side
- Hypertrophy of inferior turbinate
- Purulent discharge seen


Sinuses: Tenderness present on bil. maxillary sinus.

Nidan panchaka

Nidana – *Raja* (dust), *dhuma* (fumes), *tushar*(mist), *pragvaata* (early morning cold wide), *shetetala aahara*(frozen food), *chinta*(stress).

Poorvarupa- Nasal irritation, sneezing (kshavathu).

Rupa- thick mucoid purulent nasal discharge (*Ghana puti srava*), altered blockage and discharge, *shirashula* (headache).



Investigations

- 1. Haematological CBC WNL BSL -R 77mg/dl
- 2. Radiological examination X-ray PNS (water's view) Haziness in bilateral maxillary sinuses.

Upashaya: ushna padartha

Anupashaya: dhuma, raja, tushar, sheetambu and pragvata

Differential diagnosis

- 1. Sooryavarta
- 2. Dushtapratishyaya

Final diagnosis: Dushta pratishyaya.

Assesment criteria: subjective criteria.

Chikitsa sutra: Amapachana, kapha vilayana, kapha hara, durgandha haran, nasa marga shodhana, prakruta ghrana samjana sthapana (detoxification, expectorant, mucolytics, stimulant, nasal chanel decongestion). ^[6]

Line of treatment^[7]

• Krimi hara T/t

- Kshaya hara T/t
- Rasayan therapy
- Pratishyaya T/t

Chikitsa krama

Shodhan: Chaturjat pradhaman nasya for 5 days with an alternate day i,e, on 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th and 9th Day

Shamana: Vyoshadi Vati one tablet thrice daily for 15 days with hot water

MATERIAL AND METHODS

Nasya dravya: chaturjat churna (Twaka, Patra, Ela, Nagkeshar in same quantity)

Purvakarma: Abhyanga- with til taila. Sthanic Swedan karma

- Pradhan karma

For *nasya karma* (*dravya*) – *chaturjat churna* 100mg is administered into nostril through *pradhaman nadi yantra* in head low position of patient.

Pashchat karma – Urdhvanga massage and sthanic swedan

- **Duration of treatment** – *chaturjat pradhaman nasya* for 5 days with an alternate day i,e, on 1st,3rd,5th,7th and 9th Day & *vyoshadi vati* one tablet thrice daily for 15 days with hot water

- Follow up and assessment on 0^{th} , 7^{th} , 15^{th} and 30^{th} day

DISCUSSION

Why chaturjat pradhaman nasya is selected

- a. Main treatment for accumulated doshas in Dushta pratishyaya is shodhan nasya.
- b. Pradhaman nasya is best among all shodhan nasya.
- c. All the drugs in *chaturjat* are easily available.
- d. This *churna* contains *katu rasa*, *laghu*, *ruksha*, *tikshna*, *sukshma guna*, *ushna virya* and *katu vipaka* due to this properties drug reach the *shringataka* and irritate the mucosa of the nose and drains accumulated phlegm through the nostrils.
- e. Also this drugs having anti microbial, anti inflammatory, anti tubercular, expectorant, immunomodulatory properties.
- f. *Vyoshadi vati* having *deepen*, *pachana*, *strotoshodhan*, *vatanuloman*, *shothahara* and *rasayan* properties which helps to relief disease.

- 1. Patient got 25% symptomatic relief after 1st setting of *pradhaman nasya*.
- 2. 80% relief after 5th setting and 15 days *shaman chikitsa*.
- 3. No reccurance of disease was found in reported case.
- 4. So chaturjat pradhaman nasya and vyoshadi vati

orally is effective in T/t of chronic rhinosinusitis.

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
