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CRITICAL ANALYSIS OF BASTI KARMA IN THE MANAGEMENT OF CEREBRAL PALSY – A CASE STUDY

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ABSTRACT

Cerebral palsy is the most common cause of crippling in children these days. It results from damage to the growing brain. The prevalence of CP in children remains at 2-2.5/1000 live births in India. A specialised branch of Ayurveda known as *Kaumarbhritya* deals with the child health care and management of these disorders in children . Cerebral palsy cannot be correlated with any single disease condition in Ayurveda, it can be compared with *Shiromarmaabhighataj Vat Vyadhis* as far as its etiology and symptoms are concerned. Though CP cannot be cured completely but the quality of life as well as the dependency of the child can be reduced with suitable treatment. Here an effort was made to treat a 2 year old male child with CP using multiple Ayurveda modalities. At the end of 30 days with the use of Kshirbalatail basti a remarkable improvement in the overall effect of therapy was seen. Basti karma is described as Amrit(nectar) by acharya Kashyap that can be given in all ages. Vata dosha is the principle cause for a number of diseases therefore there is no other cure for the relieve of that increased Vatadosha except for Basti that's why learned vaidyas consider basti as Ardha chikitsa while some call it as Sampurna Chikitsa or complete treatment for the eradication of increased Vata dosha. Basti karma in paediatrics is the most useful therapy that works rightly in overall progression and advancement of child Therefore with the help of this paper the scientific evaluation and critical analysis with proper management of CP through basti in a paediatric case has been mentioned.

INTRODUCTION

- *Basti* takes over the entire body of humans from the ends of their hairs to the tips of their Nails. [1]
- Vata dosha is the principle cause of a number of diseases therefore there is no other cure for the relieve of that increased Vatadosha except for Basti. [2]
- Learned vaidyas consider Basti as Ardha chikitsa while some Vaidyas consider basti as Sampurna Chikitsa.^[3]

Cerebral palsy

- Cerebral palsy is a non progressive non fatal non curable neurological disorder that results from the damage to the growing brain.
- It is the most common cause of crippling in children

these days

- Causes could be natal, antenatal postnatal.
- It can be correlated with *Vata Vyadhis* in Ayurveda.
- Cerebral Palsy can be considered as Janma Bala Pravritta Vyadhi (congenital disorder). It can also be caused due to Doshas (bodily humors). It can be considered as Shiro Marmabhighata Vata Vyadhi (diseases caused due to injury to head).
- The motor disorder of cerebral palsy are often accompanied by disturbances of sensation, perception, cognition, communication and behavior: The incidence of cerebral palsy in India 2- 2.5/1000 live births among which 77.4% of the children are identified to be suffering with cerebral palsy. [4]

Treatment Protocol

Purvakarma for first 15 days

- Snehan Sarvang abhyang with Dhanwantar tail for 20min
- Swedan Shashtik Shali pinda swed for 20min. [5]

Pradhan karma for the next 15 days

- Basti a) k*shirbalatail* Basti started with 10 ml and then then dose ncreased to 15 ml seeing the *Samyak lakshanas* in the child
- b). Given alternately in 15 days (as per Kashyap reference)
- c) Initially 2 bastis of 10 ml
- d) Remaining 6 bastis of 15 ml

Kshirbalatail Basti

- Bala is a highly valuable drug in Ayurveda and one amongst the three most utilized raw drugs. Root of Bala (sida cordifolia) is the major ingredient of an Ayurvedic drug Ksheerbalataila used for the treatment of neurological disorders in Ayurveda. The bhaishajya kalpana vigyan has various formulas for Preparation of medicines. [6]
- One of the most popular and important oil formulations in Ayurveda is "ksheerabala Taila" (oil) known for its effectiveness in various diseases such as cerebral palsy and other neurological disorders.

- Ksheerabala Taila was first mentioned in Sahasrayogam and similar formulations has been mentioned in other classical Ayurveda texts with some different names
- Sushruta mentioned it as Bala Taila and Shata Paka Bala Taila [Sushruta Samhita, Chikitsasthana, chapter 15, verse 40-43]
- In Ashtanga Hridaya and Bhavaprakasha 4 it is mentioned as *Shata Paka- Sahasra Paka Bala Taila*. Chakradutta, Vangasena (mentioned Dashapaka *Bala Taila*, *Shata Paka-Shasra Paka Bala Taila*) and Gadanigrah quoted it as *Dashapaka Bala Taila*. National Ayurvedic formulary of India and pharmacopeia standards of Ayurvedic formulations have adopted the formula of Charaka and named as Ksheerabala Taila.

METHOD OF PREPARATION OF SHATAPAKA AND SAHASRAPAKA BALA TAILA IN CHARAKA SAMHITA AND ASTANGA HRIDAYA

Paste is prepared from 960 g of Bala Moola powder. Then, a decoction of Bala Moola is prepared by taking 61.44 kg water and reduce to ½" 1.c. 15.36 kg. 960 g sesame oil and 960 g of cow milk is added to the mixture. The mixture is heated on simmer until oil remains and water gets evaporated. The mixture is allowed to cool and filtered to obtain Ksheerabala Taila.

This process is repeated for 100 times and 1000 times to get Shata Paku Bala Taila and Sahasra Paka Bala Taila respectively.^[7]

PROPERTIES OF MAIN INGREDIENTS OF KSHEERABALA TAILA

• GO-KSHEERA

Go-Ksheera (cow milk) contains all the elements necessary for the growth and nutrition of bones, nerves, muscles and other tissues of the human body. It is Madhura in taste, Snigdha, Guru Guna property, Sheeta Veerya and Madhura Vipaka. It alleviates Vata Dosha. It is Jivaniya, Brimhaniya, Sthanya Vardhaka, Balya. Snehaniya, Dahanashaka, Ojovardhaka, Vishanasaka, Sukrajanaka, Agnidepaka, Ayurvardhaka, Medavardhaka, Rasayana, Mridu Rechaka, Abhisyanda Karaka.

• BALA

Bala is a highly valuable drug in Ayurveda and the fact that it is one amongst the three most utilized raw drugs by Ayurvedic pharmaceutics. Presently many species of Sida are recognized as Bala throughout the country. Sida cordifolia Linn. Is proposed as source plant in Ayurvedic Formulary of India". Bala, as the name itself suggests a drug providing energy or strength. It is abundantly mentioned in Ayurveda and has been largely used in neurological as well as heart diseases.^[8]

It Is kept among Balya Mahakashaya and Madhura Skandha [Charaka Samhita, Vimana Sthana, 8, verse 139] by Charaka. Sushruta has kept it among Vatashamaka Gana, hence it is best for promoting strength and alleviating Vata. The root possesses Madhura Rasa, Guru, Snigdha Guna, Sheeta Veerya and Vipaka. It is Balya, Rasayana, Brimhaniya, Oojavardhaka, Raktapitahara, Vrishya, Vatahara, Kshayanashaka, Prajastapana, Grahi. It is useful in neurological disorders.

• TIL TAIL

Sesame oil is used as a base for oil preparation". Tila Taila is Madhura Rasa and Vipaka, Balya and Rasayana in Karma; it nourishes and strengthens all Dhatu, checks Dhatukshaya and thus alleviates Vata. Snigdha and Guru Guna decreases Rukshata of Vata and with the help of Ushna Guna and veerya. [9]

On the basis of total number of basti administered types of basti include

- a) Karma Basti Total 30 Basti administered in Which there are 18 Anuvasana and 12 Niruha Basti.
- b) Kala Basti According to Charakacharya it is the half of Karma Basti. Chakrapani opines that it includes sixteen Basti out of which 10 Anuvasana and 6 are Niruha. According to Acharya Vagbhat it include 15 Basti, out of which 6 are Niruha and 9 are Anuvasana. According to Kashayap 12 Anuvasana and 3 Niruha, alternate in beginning 1 Niruha & 3 Anuvasana and at last 3 Anuvasana.

 Yoga Basti Total 8 Basti 5 Anuvasan and 3 Niruha.^[10]

TYPES OF BASTI

- 1. NiruhaBasti- It is also known as Asthapanbasti. In honey, salt, ghee is administered. Decoction enema which is mixed with this type of basti
- 2. Anuvasan basti- it is also known as *sneha* basti. In this type ghee, oil, fats, hegaloils are administered.

MATERIALS

BastiNetra (noozle) It should be made from metals like gold, silver, wood, bones, bamboo.

Gopuchhakara-corelating with shape of cow's tail. [11] Achidra-without holes (except at two ends.)

• Smooth and straight. *Gulikamukha*-tip should be like a pill.

LENGTH OF NOZZLE

For children less than 1 year- 5 angula (7.5cm) 1-7 years- 6 angula(9cm) 7years- 7angula(10.5cm) 12 years- 8 angula (12cm) 16 years-9 angula (13.5cm) 20 years onwards-12 angulas (18cm)^[12]

METHODS

Basti karma consisit of 3 parts

- 1. Purvakarma- Snehan and Swedan
- 2. Basti karma
- 3. Sansarjan karma

SNEHAN

Snehan is a purvakarma done before starting any of the panchkarmas. It is the process of doing oleation of the body Internally and externally using medicated Oils, ghee, vasa, majja.

SWEDAN

Swedan is done after snehan. It is a process Where sweating is induced artificially. It releives heaviness, stiffness, coldness of body. Maharshikashyap has defined 8 types of swedan in Children. hastswed and pat swed can be given to infants and neonates. Othersweds are Nadiswed, Prastharswed, Sankaraswed, Prad Ehaswed, Upnahaswed, Avgahswed, Paris Ekswed.

Procedure

Patient is told to lie down in left lateral position. small amount of oil is applied to anus and bastinetra(nozzle) bastinetra is Introduced into anal canal upto specific length, then bastiputak which contains bastidravya is pressed uniformly pressure is applied till small amount of bastidravya is left in bastiputak to avoid insertion of air. Then baastinetra is removed and patient Is advised to lie in supine position till he feels urge to excrete. [13]

NIRUHA BASTI MATRA

Upto 1 year- 1 pala(48gm)

• Then increase by 1 pala till it becomes 12 Pala(6 prasut, 576gm)

- At 12 years- 12 pala
- After 12 years increase each year by 2 Pala(1 prasut, 96gm) till it becomes 24 palas(12 prasuta)
- At 18 years 24 pala.
- 18-70 years- 24 pala. [14]

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- To highlight the effective role of *Kshirbalatail* basti in the management of cerebral palsy.
- To improve the attributes of life as well as to reduce the dependency of child with suitable treatment.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

- Materials are the diagnosed patient of cerebral palsy attending OPD and IPD of kaumarbhritya, Vidarbha Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Amravati was taken for research work. Kshirbalatail is one of the Sneha Kalpana (oil preparation) prepared using Kshir(cow's milk), bala Sida cordifolia,), and til tail seasame.
- Kshirbalatail basti was given after Snehan and Swedan In the whole process of analysis.
- Searches were made, for papers published by using key word Ksheerbalatail anddifferent uses of ksheerbalatail.

OBSERVATION AND RESULTS

After 1st setting -. Started making sounds Recognizes sound

After 2 - 3 setting – used to crawl back and forth, Started to sit without Support

After 4 - 5 settings – sit without support for longer time (30minutes)

After 6 -7 settings -- tries to stand holding on to a support After 8th setting --tries to stand without support for 10 seconds Started to speak monosyllables and bysyllables.

DISCUSSION

- The *snehan* therapy works as *Vatkaphashamak*, it nourishes the body thereby enhancing physical stability.
- The *sweden* therapy helps in removal of *doshas* from the body. These *doshas* have become moist by lubricant and have got liquified by sudation.
- Basti directly works on *vata dosha* bringing it back to normal, purifies the body by removing toxins also helps in internal nourishment of the body
- The action of *ksheerbalataila* could be analyzed according to the rasa panchaka of its ingredients. All the three ingredients having *madhur* rasa and *vipaka*, which is *vata* and *pittashamaka*, gives strength to Tissues and is good for sense organs and pleasing to mind
- Basti with ksheerbalataila shows positive result in cerebral palsy. Ksheerbalataila provides Snehana and brumhana in the body. It nourishes Kapha by the action of snehana which helps to subside *ruksha*, *khara gunas* of morbid vata dosha.

 Basti is considered as Ardhachikitsa. and since medicaments can directly reach the blood circulation as rectum has rich blood supply, the substances can be directly absorbed into portal circulation. And it is indicated to be used in very young and very old age also." As the child's age was very young Shodhana Basti was planned in alternate sittings.

CONCLUSION

- Management here has been done exclusively using Ayurveda medicines, appropriate Panchakarma procedures and supportive therapies.
- A remarkable improvement in the overall activities of the child within the first few days of basti were seen.
- Developmental delay and lack of activities and functions may be due to problem in normal function of Vata hence Basti was found effective to fix this increased Vata dosha to normalcy.
- Though CP is not cured completely but the suitable treatment helped improve the quality of life thereby minimizing the dependency.

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
